

TikTok and the privacy issue

What is TikTok?

TikTok is an app that allows users to create and post short, funny videos and to share them on the app itself or on other apps. It is the result of a merger with a previous app, called Musical. ly, which allowed people to produce 15-seconds videos while lip-syncing or dancing on a song.

So-far, TikTok has achieved enormous popularity, especially among teenagers, and in 2019 it registered more downloads than the most popular apps of social networking sites. However, some concern has recently emerged over the data security of TikTok users, who are mainly young people, most of them under 18.

Data security

Cyber security companies located in different countries all over the world have researched the app and noticed weaknesses linked to the access to users' data within the app itself. The weaknesses allowed attackers to send TikTok users some messages (appearing to come from the app itself) with malicious links. The researchers tested the app's security system by sending themselves links with malware. Once users clicked on the links, attackers would have been able to take control of their accounts, upload videos or gain access to their private videos.

Another flaw allowed hackers to retrieve personal information from TikTok users' accounts through the company's website. The researchers found that TikTok's site was vulnerable to a type of attack that injects

malicious code into trusted websites and were thus able to retrieve users' personal information, including names and birth dates.



Data privacy

There have also been concerns about the company's data privacy practices. The Federal Trade Commission in the US claimed violation of the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act - which requires websites and online companies to direct children under 13 to get parental consent before collecting personal information - saying that the TikTok company illegally collected personal information from minors. The Beijing company owning the app, ByteDance, is also being investigated by the British Information Commissioner's Office to determine if it violated European privacy laws that offer special protection to minors and their data. However, despite all of these issues, TikTok is still one of the most popular online products created in the last few years.
