The Dust Bowl

The Dust Bowl was the name given to the Great Plains region devastated by drought in 1930s America. The large area, including parts of Oklahoma, Texas, Kansas, Colorado and New Mexico, has little rainfall, light soil, and high winds, a potentially destructive combination. When drought struck from 1934 to 1937, the soil lacked the stronger root system of grass as an anchor, so the winds easily swirled it into dense dust clouds, called "black blizzards". Recurrent dust storms **choked** cattle and pasture lands and drove 60 percent of the population away from the region. Most of these people went to agricultural areas first and then to cities, especially on the West Coast.
