## Advantages and Disadvantages of Last Minute Travel

**Last-minute travel** is generally defined as travel taking place within about 14 days from when you booked.

Many airlines, hotels and travel agents offer major discounts on last minute reservations because it is better for them to earn at least something instead of nothing. Last minute travel deals are therefore one of the best ways to save a lot of money when travelling.

The greatest advantage of last minute travel is of course that it enables many people to visit places they otherwise could not afford.

The second benefit enjoyed by last minute travellers is surprise and adventure. Vacationers often find themselves drawn to states and countries they would never have considered.

On the other hand, last minute arrangements go hand in hand with uncertainty and require lots of flexibility and at least some adventurous spirit. In contrast to the traditional way of travelling, tourists often do not know where they are going to end up when making last minute reservations. They can be completely satisfied and have the best vacation ever, but they might also be very disappointed with the deal. Last minute travel can be stressful for some people and may not be the best idea if they are not willing to take any chances when it comes to their vacation.

Another disadvantage of last minute travel is the fact that holiday makers most likely will not be able to find a great deal for more than two people. For that reason, last minute travel may not be the best choice if they prefer to travel with more than one person.

Great last minute offers can be found both during the high season and off-season, but it may be challenging to find a great last minute deal in the most popular destinations during the peak season.

Tourists should be also very careful about last minute deals which, in reality, are not last minute at all. Due to increased popularity of last minute travel, many travel agents advertise their packages as last minute although their customers are paying the full price. It is important to keep in mind that last minute deals that are offered weeks or even months before departure are not last minute.
