An American cultural phenomenon > The National Basketball Association has been a significant part of American culture since it started. Its fan base has grown over the years, with increased global interest, and modern technology allows fans to watch games at home, making players well-known.

Origins > The National Basketball Association, commonly known as the NBA, is a top-tier professional basketball league. It started out as the Basketball Association of America (BAA) back in 1946 and officially became the NBA in 1949. Over the years, the league has seen some incredible players, thrilling championship games, and plenty of memorable moments.

Inside the NBA > It is divided into two Conferences (i.e. championships) based on geography: the Eastern Conference includes 15 teams from the eastern United States, whereas the Western Conference consists of 15 teams from the western United States. Both conferences are further organised into three divisions of five teams each.

Major NBA teams > Well-known teams of the Eastern Conference are Boston Celtics, Chicago Bulls, Cleveland Cavaliers, and Miami Heat. Big names of the Western Conference, instead, are LA Lakers, Golden State Warriors, Phoenix Suns, and Dallas Mavericks.



Long-lasting rivalry > The rivalry between Los Angeles Lakers and Boston Celtics is a milestone in NBA history: the two teams have won the highest number of championships in NBA (35 out of 78) facing off in 12 finals. Boston currently leads with 18 titles. Iconic players have shaped this rivalry across generations. Today, the Lakers are led by James LeBron and Anthony Davis, while the Celtics rely on Jayson Tatum and Jaylen Brown.

A cultural clash > The rivalry between these two iconic teams goes beyond the basketball court: they reflect the different identities of Los Angeles and Boston. On one hand, the glamourous and captivating lifestyle of the Western Coast; on the other hand, the deep-rooted traditions of the East Coast.
