How to get to Aitutaki

Daily domestic flights connect Avarua, the capital city of the Cook Islands on the island of Rarotonga, to Aitutaki; flying time is about 45 minutes. Flights from Europe are not direct and include some stopovers. Daily direct flights to Avarua from Aukland (New Zealand); the journey time is just under 6 hours outbound and 7 hours 35 minutes inbound. Weekly direct flights from Los Angeles and Tahiti. Flights from Australia connect through Auckland.
