Hair Basics - Proper shampoo technique posted by The Globe and Mail

Hair basics quiz

- 1. Hair has to be *dry / completely wet / partially wet* for a perfect emulsification before the shampoo treatment.
- 2. One pump of shampoo product is usually *more than enough / not enough / too much* depending on the length of the hair.
- **3.** The right distribution of the shampoo is with a massage with the *palms / finger nails / cushion of the fingers* in a circular motion.
- 4. Shampoo left in the scalp may cause *baldness / bad blood circulation / flakiness or dryness*.
- 5. Before applying the conditioner *don't squeeze / squeeze / never squeeze* all the excess water out of the hair.
- 6. Don't get / Try to get / Never get the conditioner too close to the scalp as it already generates enough its own oils.
- 7. The conditioner penetrates into the *cortex / cuticle / medulla* of the hair.
- 8. Use a *narrow / wide / regular* tooth comb to comb the conditioner.
- 9. Leave the conditioner on for about 1 to 2/3 to 4/2 to 3 minutes and then rinse it out.
- 10. Gently *friction / path / squeeze* the hair with the towel.

Add some hairspray to the hair if necessary.

Create a ponytail.

Go on tucking pins where necessary around the base of the ponytail.

Leave some hair hanging out to create a messy updo.

Take some small sections of the ponytail and hold the hair by the ends.

Tease the hair all the way down to the ends to give volume and create mess.

Tuck some pins into the hair to hold it in place.

Wrap the hair around the ponytail to cover up the elastic.
